

**This is a comprehensive and detailed document on Israeli violations of the Tenet
cease-fire plan since June 14, 2001.**

Wednesday June 13; 15.00hrs/ Thursday June 14; 11.00hrs

1. - Assassinations, killings and injuries

- Settlers' gunfire near the military post of Anatot kills Awni Abdel Raouf Haddad, from the village of Anata/ Jerusalem, and injures Awwad Abdel Jawad Abu Mayyalah and his two children in their car.
- Israeli army gunfire against the refugee camp of Hay Al Amal in Khan Younes injures six (6) civilians among them two (2) children.
- Israeli soldiers attack with iron sticks three children, Mohammad Khalil Al 'Akkad (9 years), Mahmoud Khalil Al 'Akkad (6) years and their brother Khaled Khalil Al 'Akkad (4 years), at the Tuffah check post in Khan Younes.
- Israeli army gunfire at the Shuhada crossing in Gaza, injurews one civilian.
- Settlers attack and injure Tahani Muhanna (20 years) and her husband Tamer Yusef Al Farabtah (27 years) on the Hebron – Bethlehem road.

2. - Gunfire with use of range of weapons.

In addition to use of weapons, as in item 1, the Israeli army breached the ceasefire on 10 different occasions in the locations listed below,

Using heavy machine guns,

Al Taybeh street, Tulkarem/ Hay Al Amal, Khan Younes./ Al Maslakh area, South of Ramallah./ Al Baddan area, Nablus./ Banat Tal Secondary school, Nablus./

Using tank shells:

Three tank shells against houses, in the Askar refugee camp in Nablus and tow tank shells against the Baddan area in Nablus, two tank shells against the factories of Abu Aida, near the Sharquiyya cemetery in Beit Hanoun.

3. - Land Confiscation.

Israeli armed forces confiscated a piece of land of 2.5 kilometers length over 250 meters width, on the site starting at the Matahen crossing, north of Quarrara up to the settlement of Netser Hazani Gush Katif in Khan Younes. Further, Israeli forces installed an electrified fence of 2 kilometers in length, thus confiscating 650 dunums of land belonging to civilians along the road of the Matahen crossing.

4. - Destruction, Leveling of Land and Uprooting of Trees.

- The Israeli army destroyed a number of sheep barracks, latticed tents and water containers belonging to civilians, near Ramallah.
- Israeli army's bulldozers backed by border security forces dug trenches around the Bqei'a area, East of Nablus.
- Israeli army bulldozed agricultural land leading to the village Marda , West of Salfit.
- Israeli army dug out the main road linking the settlement of Ariel to Salfit.
- Israeli army closed off all roads leading to the villages West of hebron.
- Israeli army closed off all main roads and bypass roads leading to Ramallah and Al Bireh.

- Israeli army prevented civilians from walking at the Surda check post by firing at anyone crossing the check post.
- Nablus is still encircled from all sides.

5. - Incursions on Area "A". and Arrests.

- Israeli army made incursions on the villages of Jammaeen and Bazzarya.
- Israeli army arrested 4 policemen in Nablus.
- Israeli army made incursions in the town Irtah, south of Tulkarem (area "B"), frightening the population and searching houses.
- The Israeli army made incursions in the town Shweikah/ Tulkarem
- Israeli tank made a 50meter incursion in area "A" south of Kassouvim/ Gaza.
- Israeli army stormed the Maqassed hospital and kidnapped the patient Rida Mahmoud Khaled, who had been injured during an assassination attempt in the refugee camp of Balata.
- Israeli army arrested and detained Ayman Abed Rabbo at the Quousin check post / student Issam Abdel Hamid from the village Quasra. Nablus/ Iyad Midhat Mahmoud 'Ajjaj at one check post in Tulkarem/Adjutant Tayseer Muqbel from the refugee camp of 'Arroub- Hebron.

6. -Settlers' Aggressions

- Settlers set fire to olive grove in the village of Masha- Salfit, burning 40 olive trees.
- Settlers bulldozed agricultural land and uprooted olive trees and grape vines in the Ras al Ein area near Al Sawiya.
- Settlers set fire to plantations belonging to civilians in the town of Huwwara, near the animal-feed factory.
- Settlers throw stones against passing cars at Tafouh crossing- Salfit.
- Settlers close the road leading from Jerusalem to the Dead Sea to Palestinian traffic.

Thursday June 14; 15.00hrs/ Friday June 15; 19.00hrs

1. - Assassinations, killings and injuries:

- Settler gunfire from the settlement of Naveh Dkalm in Khan Younes injured 6 civilians and 4 children:
- Nu'man Muhammad Fayyad (21 years) in a critical condition
- Raed Saaban Muhammad Tabash (38 years),
- Hasan Muhammad Ahmad Al Sisy (17 years),
- Muhammad Ibrahim Ba'ra (16 years),
- Ibrahim Abdel Karim Al Salmy (12 years),
- Samir Haydar Kallab (18 years),
- Fahed Riyad Al Sa'douni (12 years) in a serious condition,
- Ibrahim Al Shina (13 years)
- Israeli army gunfire against al Amal residential neighborhood, in Khan Younes injured: Saad Al Sa'douni.
- 14 civilian were injured by gunfire at the northern entrance of Al Bireh.
- Israeli army gunfire injured Japanese journalist Shizo Yoto Kazimati in the hand.

2.- Gunfire with use of range of weapons.

The Israeli army breached the ceasefire on 9 different occasions in the locations listed below:

- Israeli army gunfire near point 7, from Tal Za'reb eastwards.
- Israeli army opened machine gunfire from Salah Eddin crossing northwards.
- Four tank shells were fired from Salah Eddin crossing northwards.
- Israeli army fired tear gas canisters and live ammunition from military position of Jani Tal settlement in the direction of civilian's houses in al Amal neighborhood, west of Khan Younes and at point 9, security line, injuring 3 civilians and 3 children with live bullets.

- Gunfire at a civilian Mercedes car at the Matahen intersection in Gaza. The car was stopped, searched and the 3 passengers were arrested.
- Five Israeli army patrols opened fire on a peaceful demonstration, after Friday prayer, at the northern entrance of El Bireh. Using live bullets and steel bullets as well as a new type of fire shells and poisoned gas shells Israeli forces injured a number of civilians, and leaving a Japanese journalist with a hand injury.

3.- Destructions, Leveling of Land and Uprooting of trees.

- Israeli army destroyed livestock farms and latticed tents, confiscates water containers and animal feed belonging to 3 families in the Bqei'a area, Jenin.

4. - Incursions in area "A" and Arrests.

- Israeli army entered the town of Kufr Al Deek/ Salfit, and attacked the inhabitants.
- Israeli army increased its presence and fired light bombs in the Abboud area, west of Ramallah.
- Israeli army arrested: Mahmoud Fathi muhammad Jawabra, and Ibrahim Muhammad Mussa Abu Mustapha, at the Bazzaria crossing check post.
- Israeli army arrested Mahmoud Saleh Zbeidat and Jaser Saleh Zbeidat at the military check post near Al Baddan.
- Israeli army arrested 5 Palestinians in the Old City of Jerusalem.
- The 3 passengers of the Mercedes car are still under arrest.(ref: point 2)

5. Settlers' Aggressions.

- Settlers from Naveh Tsouf' established new settlement point near Abboud/ Ramallah.
- Settlers from Ofra planned a new settlement position near Khirbat Aliah.
- Group of settlers installed 6 caravans on a hilltop road that links Deir Samet to the town of Dura/ Hebron and installed sewer pipe work.
- Extremist settlers attacked the town of Abboud and the villages of Deir Abou Mash'al and Beit Rima, in Ramallah and set fire to tens of olive trees, and smashed windows of houses at the edge of the town.
- Settlers from the settlement point known as Deir Aban set fire to lands planted with olive trees and almond trees belonging to the village of Kufr Al Balad in Tulkarem (adjacent to the settlement). The fire destroyed over 100 Dunums of land.
- Settlers attacked the village of Jourish and bulldozed vast areas of land and uprooted 85 olive trees.
- Groups of settlers attacked passing cars and civilians at the Muthallath Zaatara check post/ Nablus.

Friday June 15; 19.00hrs/ Saturday June 16; 19.00hrs

1.- Assassinations, Killings and Injuries.

- Israeli army gunfire, using rubber-coated steel bullets, against peaceful demonstration in Halhoul injured 4 civilians.
- Israeli army opened fire against youngsters near the Tuffah checkpoint injuring: Hazem Samir Abu Dallal (12 years)- bullet wound in the foot, Riyadh Muhammad Abu Odeh (14 years) - bullet injury in both feet, Ahmad Muhammad Shehadeh (17 years) - bullet wound in the lower side, Muhammad Ayman Shakshak (17 years) – bullet wound in the right foot, Shadi Basir Queytah (17 years), two bullet wounds in both feet.
- Israeli army opened fire during assault on the town of Abboud/ Ramallah, and injured Yussef Joudeh (40 years) and Saeed Elias (60 years).
- Israeli army unjustified gunfire causes shoulder injury to Ibrahim Saeed Ayyad (25 years) at the Minthar crossing.

2.- Gunfire with use of range of weapons

In addition to gunfire, as in item 1, the Israeli army breached ceasefire on 5 different occasions using machine guns in the areas of: South of Soufa/ Rafah, Al Tuffah checkpoint/

Khan Younes, Al Khader area/ Bethlehem and during an assault on the town of Abboud/ Ramallah.

3.- Destruction, Leveling of Land and Uprooting of Trees:

Israeli forces have started vast operations of leveling and bulldozing Palestinian lands near 'Aneen, Baqa Al Sharquiyya and Tourah at the border of the green line to open a new settler road and the expansion of the settlements near Jenin and Tulkarem.

- Israeli forces' bulldozers have started today opening a 2-kilometer long road on lands belonging to civilians in the Yatta area/ Hebron.
- Israeli forces bulldozed and leveled lands aimed at the expansion of the Ma'oun settlement.
- Israeli forces' bulldozed vast areas of land on top of Jerezim mountain, near the city of Nablus and the adjacent refugee camps.
- Israeli forces' bulldozers dug a half a kilometer long trench, with a 2 meters depth and a 4 meters width next to the bypass road east of the village of Salem /Nablus.

4.- Incursions of area "A" and arrests.

- Israeli army carried out incursions in Abou 'Areef road/ Kfar Darom area and arrested Adel Bahseer.
- Israeli military fortified positions at point 200 east of Soufa/ Gaza.
- Israeli army sets up a number of checkpoints at the entrance of the town of Bait 'Amr, Al 'Arroub, and Al Fawwar in Hebron.
- Arrest and detention of Muhammad Hamzah Hamarsheh at the Kifrit checkpoint – Ya'bed/ Jenin.
- Arrest and detention of: Rami Abdel Quader Ramaylah, Shelker Mahmoud Mansour and Sufian Hamadi 'Eid Ziad at the Mixmas crossroad in Hebron.
- **Missing:** Fida' Abdallah Abdel Jalil has been missing for 6 days.
- Israeli forces carried out incursion in the town of 'Azzoun/ Qualquilya.

5.- Situation on Roads and at Border Crossings

- **Border Crossings:** Beit Hanoun – Gaza Airport - Soufa – Moraj: **Closed.**
- The Abou 'Ajeen road is open only to the military.
- Tal Al Sultan road is open only to pedestrians.
- **Roads closed in the Gaza Strip:**
- Road Number 4/ Shuhada crossing – Abou Houli – Moraj – the Tuffah checkpoint.
- **In Gaza:** the Israeli army repositioned armed and armored vehicles at the Shuhada crossing near Netzarim, after they moved them for a few hundred meters on June 14.
- Concrete blocks and dirt bumps are maintained at the check posts on main crossroads.
- **In the West Bank:** Some roads were cleared of dirt mounds, while the army fortified and increased military check posts. Majority of roads closed. All reopened roads were re-closed including the Nablus- Tulkarem road.

6.- Settlements and settler aggressions

- Israeli ministry of Housing announced that it submitted to tender, under number "2001/9026" for the building of 2900 housing units in the area of Jabal Abou Ghneim, in addition to the improvement of the infrastructure for an amount of 210 million shekels. Bids will start on June 26 2001 in the offices of the Jerusalem District, 23 Hillel Street. 4th Floor. Jerusalem.
- Settlers from the Avni Hiftes settlement attacked the olive orchids in the village Kufri Al Labad/ Tulkarem burning over 1000 olive plants.
- Settlers assault land east of the village of 'Akraba in Nablus and set fire to 200 olive trees.

Saturday June 16; 19.00hrs/Sunday June 17; 19.00hrs

1. - Assassinations, killings and injuries

- Israeli tank fire at the Salah Eddine crossing on Saturday, June 16, kills Ali Murad Abu Shawish (11 years) from Khan Younes, and severely injured 4 other children one of them critically.
- Gunfire at the Salah Eddine crossing injured 3 children on Sunday June 17.
- 4 Israeli tank shells at the Salah Eddine crossing injured Ezzeddine Abdel Rahman (22 years) and Muhammad Awad (21 years).
- Israeli gunfire during assault attempt on the town of Abu Dis injured two civilians.
- Israeli gunfire injured Muhammad Daoud Abu Turki (6 years) from Abou Sneineh neighborhood in Hebron.

2. - Gunfire with use of range of weapons.

The Israeli army breached the ceasefire on 6 different occasions using machine guns and tank fire in the following locations:

25 tank shells at Salah Eddin Gate and at point 7 – security line/ Rafah.

On two different occasions in Khan Younes , in Hebron, in Abou Dis and in the village of Hares/ Salfit.

3. - Destruction, Leveling of Land and uprooting of Trees.

- Israeli army set fire to over 100 olive trees in the area of Khallat Rmeilah west of Salfit.
- Israeli bulldozers continue land leveling on top of Mount Jerezim/ Nablus, and bulldozed tens of dunums in forested land replacing trees with cement blocks.

4. - Incursions in area "A" and arrests.

- Israeli army arrested Lieutenant Mahmoud Al Barghouti and Sergeant Hazem Yussef Al Rimawi at the Surda checkpoint / Ramallah. Both men belong to the Military Liaison.
- Israeli forces entered the town of Irtah/ Tulkarem and the town of Hares/ Salfit.
- Israeli forces are massing tanks and increasing patrols on the bypass road opposite the village of Zawata/ Nablus, possibility of attack or advance in this direction.
- Israeli army assault on the town of Aqraba / Nablus and Deir Sharaf is still under severe closure. Heavy patrol presence in Burin.

5. - State of the Roads and border crossings.

- Most border crossings are still closed, with the exception of the Rafah and Minthar border crossing as well as Al Karamah border crossing. Extreme difficulties facing civilians.
- Most main roads are still closed.
- Re-closure of some of the roads that were opened on June 16.
- Increase of military check posts on open roads. Searches increased, causing extreme distress to civilians.

6. - Settlements and settlers' aggressions.

- The economic and social council of ministers approved the plan proposed by Sharansky to encourage building, by offering grants, financial assistance and loans with easy repayments, in the West Bank and in the new quarters in Jerusalem by the settlers.
- Settlers in the center of Tel Rumeidah, in Hebron and contrary to the decision of the Israeli High Court, have continued settlement building in the area with the purpose of setting up 7 permanent houses. This comes within the framework of the settlement expansion plan of 14 new housing units.
- Settlers bulldozed tens of dunums east of Jalloud/ Nablus and brought new caravans to the area placing them in the new settlement points.
- Settlers uprooted 80 olive trees from land belonging to the village of Jourish/ Nablus.
- Settlers continue the leveling of land belonging to civilians in the town of Al Zawiya, uprooting olive trees and bulldozing land for the second consecutive day.

- Settlers from the Kyriat Arbaa settlement in Hebron attacked and severely beat up Muhammad Awni Da'na (10 years), Duha Awni Da'na (8 years) and Shadi Awni Da'na (6 years).

Sunday June 18; 19.00hrs/Monday June 19; 19.00hrs

1. - Assassinations, killings and injuries

- Citizen Ahmad Mahmoud Ali, 71 years old, from Beit Amin town in Qalqilya, was run over deliberately and killed by a Jewish settler.
- The occupation forces opened fire at the vehicle of Ahmad Said, 39 years old, near AL Shuhada junction in Gaza, wounding him in the shoulder.

2. - Gunfire with usage of range of weapons.

- The Israeli army breached the cease-fire agreement using machineguns and artillery fire five times in the following areas: AL Shuhada junction in Gaza, Dair Sharaf in Nablus, Gaza Sea, Hawarah in Nablus.
- The occupation forces fired a tank shell at Kassarat AL Salouss area and opened machinegun fire at the same area.
- A military frigate opened fire at Gaza fishermen then they tore apart their fishing nets.
- Gunfire shots were fired from the gates of Netzarim settlement at Zahra City.

3. Confiscation of land:

- The occupation authorities confiscated 17 Dunums in Wadi AL Namel area and Khalet al Sokhol to the south of Betounia\Ramallah

3. - Destruction, Leveling of Land and uprooting of Trees.

- The Israeli bulldozers started to dig a new trench in Sahel AL Buqai'a to the east of Tobas in AL Aghawar area towards the military post on AL Buqai'a-Aghawar AL Naseria junction. This action isolated the northern and middle Aghawar areas.

4. - Incursions in area "A" and arrests.

- A large contingent of the occupation forces is besieging Burqa village in Nablus and imposing a curfew on the village until further notice.
- The Israelis erected barbed wire at the northern border of Kfar Darom settlement that extends to the eastern border on road no. (4) Salah EL Din main road. The barbed wire extends from the northern direction and intersects with the island in the middle of Salah EL Din road then extends eastward with a length of 800 meters to surround the settlement.
- The occupation forces prevented an ambulance from entering Beit Dajjan village to transport Raed Mostafa Sliman Amer in spite of prior co-ordination with the Israeli Liaison committee.
- The occupation forces stopped a Palestinian vehicle on Awarta military check post near Ajjouri house and transported its passengers to Hawarah military camp.
- The occupation forces carried out a campaign of arrests in several villages like Salem, Beit Foreek, Aqraba, Saweya and Beit Dajjan and they arrested the college student Shadi Sabti Hamed from Beit Dajjan. Arrest of 3 residents of Salem village, Mahmoud Faleh Jabbour, Ahmad Tawfique Ataway and Othman Abed Ishtia.
- The occupation forces combed the area of Kassarat AL Salouss in Dair Sharaf. Military vehicles were seen moving in the area and on the bypass road of Shafi Shomron.
- The occupation forces arrested" Nasri Ibrahim AL Aqra' at Awarta\Nablus junction, Said Yassine Mansour Daoud at Qalandia check post, Bassam Talab Mohammad AL Atel at Qalandia check post and Asa'd Tawfique Hamdan from Qalqilya at Karni Shomron junction member of the Preventive Security Force.

- The occupation forces arrested 4 youths from the village of Hawwara/ Nablus, on Qoseen road.
- The occupation forces erected two new military posts on an area of 500 meters in Wadi AL Salqa and Abu Ajjen, areas to the south of the Gaza Strip, on lands under the control of the PA.

5. - State of the Roads and border crossings.

- Closure is still imposed on all the Palestinian areas in general, including roads that the occupation forces claimed re- opened. Palestinian vehicles are stopped and kept waiting for a long time, some vehicles are prevented from proceeding to their destination. In addition several citizens are detained and interrogated by the occupation forces.
- A military Personnel carrier and a military jeep closed down AL Shuhada junction in Gaza for a period of time. This action was repeated twice without any apparent reason.
- The occupation forces prevented Palestinian citizens from using the main road near Burqa village to insure the passage of settlers.

6. - Settlements and settlers' aggressions.

- An Israeli vehicle opened fire at a Palestinians vehicle near Hawarah village in Nablus.
- Jewish settlers attacked Palestinian houses near the bypass road near Madama village and burnt a Palestinian vehicle.

Monday June 18; 19.00hrs/Tuesday June 19; 19.00hrs

1. - Assassinations, killings and injuries

- Fatima Elayyan Abu Farawa, 70 years old, was killed after being run over deliberately by an Israeli vehicle on Qalqilya – Alfe Manshe road.
- The Israeli army opened fire at point (12), the Namsawi security line in Khan Younis, injuring a 15-year-old youth Abed AL Rahman AL Salmi in the abdomen.
- The Israeli army opened fire at a group of Palestinian youths at point (8), security line Amal neighborhood in Khan Younis, injuring a 14-year-old youth Fadi Abu Amona with a bullet that penetrated both of his legs and three others.

2. - Gunfire with usage of range of weapons.

- The Israeli army breached the cease-fire agreement using machine-guns and artillery fire eleven times in the following areas: AL Amal neighborhood and Tofah check post\Khan Younis, Salah El Din Gate, Zurob Tower and AL Salam neighborhoods\ Rafah, Beit "Hanoun, Nabi Elyas towns, Kufor Tholoth, Kufor Laqef and Azzoun\ Qalqilya and Hawarah and Sowana\Nablus.
- Sporadic gunfire at point (42) on the border line to the east of Beit Hanoun village.
- Israeli gunfire from point (5) on the Egyptian border-AL Salam neighborhood.
- A Jewish settler opened fire at a public vehicle with 5 passengers inside it on Azzoun-Qalqilya road.
- Jewish settlers opened fire at a Palestinian vehicle owned by Qalqilya municipality when it was passing near Nabi Elyas town. They also opened fire at other public vehicles when they were passing through Kufor Tholoth and Kufor Laqef villages.
- The Israeli army opened its high caliber machinegun fire at residential houses in Salah El din gate area and AL Tofah checkpoint area without any reason.
- Jewish settlers opened fire at Yousif Zahi Odeh's vehicle in Hawarah and at a store owned by the mayor of the city.
- Two armored personnel carriers at point (9) on the Egyptian border near Tal Zurob indiscriminately opened fire at all directions.
- Light flares were fired in the skies followed by heavy gunfire from armored personnel carriers in Sawana\Nablus.

3. Confiscation of land:

- Ma'lieh Shomron settlers bulldozed more than 100 Dunums in Kofur Tholoth \Qalqilya to annex them to the settlement.

4. - Destruction, Leveling of Land and uprooting of Trees.

- Jewish settlers burnt hundreds of Dunums planted with olive trees belonging to Kafer Qaddoum\Qalqilya residents between Beit Rameed and Beit Leed towns, which are under curfew. The occupation forces prevented fire trucks from reaching the area.
- The occupation forces bulldozed 20 Dunums near AL Matahen area that is under the control of the PA. They also put pebbles and stones inside the area in addition to erecting barbed wire around it in a preparatory step to erect a military camp in the area.
- An Israeli bulldozer demolished a wall that surrounds Sliman Shehada house in Ein Yabrood to the north of Ramallah.
- Under the protection of Israeli army and with the aid of Jewish settlers a bulldozer leveled and uprooted olive trees to the south of Moraj settlement in Rafah.

5. - Incursions in area "A" and arrests.

- A fishing boat was stopped in Gaza Sea and its crew arrested and transported to Ashdod area.
- The Israeli army stormed in a Naval post in Rafah then they chased down the fishermen.
- Three Israeli patrols stormed in Birzeit City and combed the nearby area.
- The occupation forces stormed in A'ba and Beit Leed towns in Tolkarem.
- The occupation forces stormed in Madama village in Nablus. There is heavy presence to the occupation army in the area.
- The occupation forces arrested near Dair AL Balah 4 citizens and two from Um AL Safa village, two from Tolkarem, one from Jerusalem, and another one from Mawasi\Khan Younis.
- The occupation forces arrested a number of citizens at the checkpoint on the main road in Dair Depwan village to the north of Ramallah.
- The Israeli army arrested Abed AL Kareem Mohammad Abed AL Kareem from Beit Reema\Ramallah and Ammar Ahmad Khalil, from Kufor Ein\Ramallah who works in the national security force, at a military checkpoint on the entrance of Nabi Saleh town in Ramallah.
- A special Israeli unit arrested 3 citizens from Noor Shames camp in Zeeta village. The arrested are: Yousid Karsou, From Preventive Security force, Imad Nimer AL Araj, Mamdouh Jaber Abu Zaiter.
- The occupation forces arrested three youths from Zeeta village\Tolkarem.

6. - State of the Roads and border crossings.

- Closure is still imposed on all the Palestinian areas in general, including roads that the occupation forces claimed re- opened. Palestinian vehicles are stopped and kept waiting for a long time, some vehicles are prevented from proceeding to their destination. In addition several citizens are detained and interrogated by the occupation forces.

7. - Settlements and settlers' aggressions.

- Jewish settlers ran over the 15-year-old youth Waseem Adnan Rida from Nazlet Issa village.
- Jewish settlers hurled two Molotov cocktail bombs on a gas station in Burqa Nablus.
- Jewish settlers burnt olive and almonds trees in Rameen\Tolkarem.
- Hebron settlers took over more Palestinian stores in the vegetable market in the old city and started to renovate them.
- Jewish settlers attacked Madama village and burnt Ramez Nassar's and Mostaf Najjar vehicles. They also attacked Yasser Qut's house from Madama. The occupation forces aided the settlers by opening fire and gas canisters at the residents.

- Jewish settlers entered Um Safa town in area "B" and vandalized the residents' properties.
- Jewish settlers broke several cars' and houses' windows in Hawarah and Boreen villages.
- Three settler's cars intersected a Palestinians car from Nablus and poured Patrol on the car and burnt it.

Tuesday June 19; 19.00hrs/Wednesday June 20; 19.00hrs

1. - Assassinations, killings and injuries

- Jamal Mohammad Odeh Nafe', 30 years old from Na'leen to the north of Ramallah, was killed and two others were critically wounded when the occupation forces opened fire at their car near a military blockade to the north west of Ramallah.
- A 5-year-old child Islam Tareq Hanany was wounded when he was hit directly by a gas canister in the head. He suffered a fractured skull as a result and was admitted to the hospital in critical condition.
- Seven Palestinian youths were wounded near AL Tofah checkpoint in Khan Younis when the occupation forces opened fire on them, one of the wounded is a 12-year-old boy.

2. - Gunfire with usage of range of weapons.

- The Israeli army breached the cease-fire nine times using machineguns and artillery fire in addition to the breaches mentioned in the previous point:
- The Israeli army opened fire from 15 military jeeps at a National Security post at Rameen village's entrance in Area "A".
- The Israeli army opened fire and light flares at Nabi Saleh, Aboud and Beit Reema\ Ramallah.
- The Israeli army opened fire at the citizens in Amal neighborhood in Khan Younis without any provocation.
- The Israeli army stationed at Sirda checkpoint to the north of Ramallah, opened fire at Palestinian vehicles passing on the sandy roads near AL Jalazoun camp.
- Israeli F16 warplanes fired heat balloons in Rafah, Jenin, Qarara, Khan Younis and Gaza. In addition, Israeli warplanes and helicopter gun ships implemented false attacks in Beit Foreek.

3. - Destruction, Leveling of Land and uprooting of Trees.

- The village council of Rameen confirmed that 2200 Dunums planted with olive and almond trees were burnt by Jewish settlers yesterday.
- The Israeli army bulldozed lands erected sand barriers at the entrance of Bazaria.

4. - Incursions in area "A" and arrests.

- The Israeli army entered the Gaza Strip in three areas: Rafah, Maghazi and Qarara using Tanks and machinegun fire.
- The Israeli army was deployed in Burqa\Nablus and the Israeli warplanes flew over the area.
- The Israeli army entered 200 meters into area "A" to the east of Qarara in the south of the Gaza Strip.
- The occupation forces stormed in Kufor AL Deek\Salfet town and stormed in the several residents' houses and vandalized their contents. They also arrested Ahmad Mostafa Mosa and beat him and broke his arm. They also arrested Yehya Yousif Hassan, 25 years old.
- The occupation forces stormed in AL Ezaria\Jerusalem after they besieged the city with soldiers and military vehicles.
- Israeli reinforcements on Beit Foreek – Beit Dajjan road and the entrance of Madama village. They also confiscated a Palestinian vehicle that they used to chase down the citizens.

- Israeli army units in plain cloths burnt olive trees and farms in Dair Sharaf.
- A large gathering of Jewish settlers under the protection of the Israeli army was seen near Seelat AL Thohor village. They arrested Nasha't Jeeb Abu Diyab and 20 others.
- The occupation forces arrested a Fateh activist Yasser Aby, 32 years old from AL Ezaria\Jerusalem along with two others from Tolkarem and Beit Reema\Ramallah.
- The occupation forces arrested Shadi Fleeh Hamed from Beit Dajjan\Nablus and Mahmoud Ahmad Fadi from Saweyah\Nablus on a military blockade in Jenin.

5. - State of the Roads and border crossings.

- Closure is still imposed on all the Palestinian areas in general, including a lot of roads that the occupation forces claimed re- opened. Palestinian vehicles are stopped and kept waiting for a long time in the opened roads, some vehicles are prevented from proceeding to their destination. In addition several citizens are detained and interrogated by the occupation forces.
- The Israeli port and harbor authority has decreased their workload in Rafah crossing on the directions of the Israeli army.
- The occupation forces erected military checkpoints on Qalqilya-Nablus road and stopped the Palestinian vehicles and damaged their tires.

6. - Settlements and settlers' aggressions.

- Building of settlements is still continuing according to Israel land Administration. More than 50% of bids are ready for tender and 708 tenders have been released in the West Bank.
- The army intends to build a military point in the Jewish cemetery in Heron and erecting a settlement point on a hill located between Ofreem & Majdoleem settlements to the north west of Ramallah.
- Jewish settlers burnt olive trees in Azzoun and Izba Abu Khmaish \Qalqilya, Aboud Village\Ramallah, Ezaria\Jerusalem, Jayous, Habla and Fufor Kaddoum in Qalqilya in addition to Rameen and Beit Leed in Tolkarem.
- Jewish settlers burnt farms and olive trees near Burqa\Nablus. Ennab settlers burnt 50 Dunums planted with olive & almond trees in Beit Leed.
- Jewish settlers burnt olive trees in Selwad\Ramallah.

Wednesday June 20; 19.00hrs/Thursday June 21; 19.00hrs

1. - Assassinations, killings and injuries

- Abed AL Aziz Shaker Za'rour, 35 years old, was wounded with live ammunition after being shot at from the Israeli army stationed in Seelat Al Thohor.
- Three Palestinians were wounded by Israeli gunfire in Amal neighborhood\Khan Younis, among them is a 14-year-old child who is in critical condition.
- Tawfique Abed Razeq Rayyan was wounded in the leg by live ammunition after the Israeli army stationed to the west of Salfet indiscriminately opened fire at the citizens.

2. - Gunfire with usage of range of weapons.

- The Israeli army breached the cease-fire agreement using machineguns and artillery fire three times in the following areas, in addition to the breaches in paragraphs 1 and 6:
- The occupation forces fired its high caliber machineguns and light flares on Madama, Boreen and Tal villages in Nablus.
- An armored personnel carrier stationed at Abu Joba gas station on the eastern line fired a bullet at Fahed post near Karni crossing.
- The Israeli army opened fire at AL Ghussain oxygen factory in Gaza.

3. - Incursions in area "A" and arrests.

- Massive occupation troops' movements and presence, backed up with at least 10 military jeeps, were seen in Madama, Boreen and Tal villages in Nablus.

- The Israeli army massed up a large contingent of troops that entered Atara area (Between Bazaria and AL Seela) in area "A".
- An Israeli military frigate pulled out and tore the fishermen's nets in Rafah area. The fishermen were fishing within the permitted fishing area.
- The Israeli army stormed in Seelat AL Thohor village\Jenin, occupied several schools, closed down three general secondary school test halls and severely beat up several residents. The army also deployed more military vehicles in the area and imposed a curfew on the village.
- Eight Israeli patrols stormed in Abu Dis village to the east of Jerusalem and 4 of the patrols closed down the entrance of the Governorate of Jerusalem.
- The Israeli bulldozers are digging trenches on all unpaved roads in the vicinity of Boreen village and erecting sand barriers behind the trenches to isolate the village from the outside world.
- The occupation forces backed up with military vehicles arrested a Palestinian citizen on AL Haker checkpoint to the south of Dair Al Balah and detained several citizens then beat them up.
- The occupation forces arrested Mohammad Hashem Nawwara on Serda checkpoint\Ramallah, Shadi Adawy near Shuwaika in a land owned by the agriculture ministry, Yasser Rabaya' after they stormed in his house in Ezaria and Omar Khalaf, Abdelhamid Mughanem, Abbas Odeh and Saleh Mohammad when they stormed in Rashadia town\Bethlehem.
- The occupation forces arrested two citizens from Hares\Salfect and transported them to an unknown location.
- The occupation forces occupied a house in Burqa\Nablus and erected a military point on its roof to watch the residence's movements.

4. - State of the Roads and border crossings.

- The occupation forces reinforced its military aggression and siege on AL Mawasi area\Khan Younis. They prevented the farmers from reaching their farms and erected more military blockades inside the area, in addition to the deployment of patrols between the houses and farms.
- The occupation forces reinforced its presence on the major, minor and bypass roads in Nablus and prevented Palestinian citizens' movements. They also isolated the city of Nablus from its rural surroundings specially the southern rural part. In addition, They erected several military checkpoints on Nablus-Ramallah road and hindered the movement of Palestinian citizens.
- The vast majority of West Bank's roads are still closed.

5. - Settlements and settlers' aggressions.

- Kawkab Yacoub Jewish settlers released tens of mad dogs in Sateh Marhaba to the south east of AL Birah that spread fear among the children and adults alike.
- Under the protection of the Israeli army, Jewish settlers burnt down Hashem Mahmoud AL Najjar's house and his bus.
- Homesh Jewish settlers to the north of Nablus opened fire at the residents of Masoudia, Bazaria, Burqa and Sabastia. They also fired at the residents to prevent them from putting out the fire that the settlers had set to village's trees.
- Jewish settlers burnt down Ashraf Jabber's vehicle who is an employee in Aqraba Municipality\Nablus on Yanon-Aqraba road.
- Karneh Shomron Jewish settlers closed down the main Qalqilya-Nablus road near Kufor Laqef junction. They also burnt rubber tires, prevented Palestinian vehicles from passing by and hurled rocks at them that damaged several of them.
- Jewish settlers indiscriminately opened fire at resident's houses to the west of Hares village\Salfect. Among the houses were Hazza' Qassem's and Yasseen Akel's. They returned later with a larger number of settlers and almost 15 vehicles with the protection of the Israeli army patrols and fired heavy gunfire, gas canisters and sound bombs at the residents.

- AL Qanna Jewish settlers started to bulldoze and uproot olive trees to the west of Masha\Salfeet, to what is known as Helou mountain, in a preparatory step to build a road and more settlement points. The land is estimated at more than 200 Dunums that is owned by the deceased Qassem Amer's, Ibrahime Ammer and others. The occupation authority has released an order to confiscate more than 2000 Dunums to the west of Masha.
- Jewish settlers closed down AL Shoyoukh-Sa'er road to the east of Hebron and hurled rocks at Palestinian vehicles that damaged several of them.
- Amona'el Jewish settlers burnt thousands of Dunums planted with olive and almonds trees, belonging to Zeta, Jima'en and Kafel Hares\Salfeet. Fire brigade could not reach the area because of the closure of the road by the Israeli army with concrete blocks and sand barriers.
- Armed Jewish settler driving a tractor attacked a piece of land in Laban Al Sharqia near the gas station and damaged crops and 200 olive plants belonging to Kamel Mahmoud Khader.

Thursday June 21; 19.00hrs/Friday June 22; 19.00hrs

1. Assassinations, killings and injuries

- A Palestinian was wounded in AL Khader village When an Israeli soldier fired at Palestinian demonstrators.
- The occupation forces opened fire at Palestinian protestors near Balo' checkpoint\Ramallah and wounded three Palestinians by rubber-coated bullets and gas bombs.
- The occupation forces fired rubber-coated bullets and gas bombs at Palestinian demonstrators near Khaddoury checkpoint\Tolkarem and wounded one of them.
- Israeli battle tanks' fired high caliber machineguns at Beit Lahia village and critically injured three Palestinian civilians.
- The Israeli army opened fire at Palestinian citizens at AL Muntar crossing and wounded 16 – year-old Mohammed AL Zahhar\AL Nasser neighborhood with live ammunition in the right thigh and 17-year-old Shareef Rafique Ayyad\ Shejai'a neighborhood, with live ammunition in the left leg.
- The Israeli army opened fire at the residents of AL Amal neighborhood and wounded 18-year-old Mohammed Sami Abu Sol, with ten bullets in the right foot and 13-year-old Ahmad Saleh Abu Odeh, with live ammunition in the ear.

2. Gunfire with usage of range of weapons.

- The Israeli army breached the cease-fire agreement using machineguns' fire several times in the following areas, in addition to the breaches in paragraphs 1 and 6:
- The occupation forces fired live ammunition, rubber-coated bullets and gas bombs at the residents of Single and Tormosia villages.
- The occupation forces opened machinegun fire on the residents of Seelat AL Thohor village\Jenin.
- Israeli army units stationed at Tal Zorob opened fire at the eastern direction.

3. Destruction, Leveling of Land and Uprooting of Trees.

- The occupation forces bulldozed an orchid near AL Mughraqa mosque.

4. Incursions in area "A" and arrests.

- Regular Israeli army & special units stormed in Burqa village and attacked and beat up several residents among them Abed Razeq Hantooly. They also destroyed a number of private vehicles.
- Israeli police arrested three Palestinian citizens in Jerusalem.
- The occupation forces arrested Ashraf Atta Sultan\Hares village and Rayed Nabhan Bani Fadel near Habla\Qalqilya.

5. State of the Roads and border crossings.

- The Israeli army checkpoints are spread all over the roads that were re-opened and are hindering the movement of traffic. In addition, most of the major roads are still closed.

6. Settlements and settlers' aggressions.

- An Israeli machinery guard on Israel crossing road near AL Naqqar neighborhood\Qalqilya opened fire at a group of Palestinian youths and an Israeli border police patrol also participated in the gunfire.
- Under the protection of the occupation forces, Shilo Jewish settlers gathered on Single & Tormosia junction to the north of Ramallah, and closed down Ramallah-Nablus road, attacked Palestinian houses on the main road and burnt farmlands.
- Tens of Jewish settlers attacked Boreen village and set fire to the village's lands. The fire spread to olive orchards when the settlers prevented the fire brigade from putting out the fire.
- Jewish settlers burnt Beet Leed village's lands\Tolkarem, which is under curfew. In addition, another group of Jewish settlers burnt wheat and agricultural crops in Single village\Ramallah.
- Jewish settlers attacked and hurled rocks at Palestinian vehicles, and beat up Palestinian journalists at the entrance of Hebron.
- Jewish settlers attacked a resident of Izna village\Hebron and destroyed his car near Sa'eer\Hebron.
- For the second time in a row today, Yetschar Jewish settlers burnt crops and olive trees in Boreen village and prevented Nablus fire brigade from reaching the area.
- A group of Jewish settlers arrived at the plastic factory in Dair Sharaf and burnt olive orchards.
- Shafi Shomron Jewish settlers attacked and hurled rocks at Palestinian vehicles near Masoudia on Jenin-Nablus road.

Friday June 22; 19.00hrs/Saturday June 23; 19.00hrs

1. Assassinations, killings and injuries

- A 20-year-old Muhanad Swedan from Nuseirat camp was killed and two others wounded by Israeli gunfire to the east of Maghazi camp\Gaza Strip.
- Five Palestinians were wounded by Israeli fire during a peaceful demonstration in Aboud village\Ramallah.
- A Palestinian citizen was critically wounded by shrapnel when Israeli battle tanks opened fire on Rafah camp while storming in the camp.

2. Gunfire with usage of range of weapons.

- The Israeli army breached the cease-fire agreement using machineguns' fire several times in the following areas, in addition to the breaches in paragraphs 1 and 6:
- The Israeli army opened gunfire on Palestinians citizens near Abu AL Ajeen road and Gush Qatif Settlement\Gaza.
- Heavy machinegun fire on the bypass road "Zwata" and movements of military vehicles were seen in the area.
- The Israeli forces opened machinegun fire at a National Guard post at Beit Eba entrance\Nablus.
- The Israeli forces opened fire and tear gas bombs at Palestinians in Seelat AL Thohor, which is under curfew, when they went out to buy food supplies and baby's milk. Several of them suffered suffocation and commas among them were several children.
- The Israeli battle tanks stormed in Rafah camp from Block J and positioned at the road near the camp and opened fire on all directions. They were supported by military towers gunfire in Tal Zorob and Salah EL Din military positions.
- Israeli forces opened fire at Palestinians vehicles in Sabastia, Burqa and Bazaria villages that lead to the escape of its passengers.

3. Destruction, Leveling of Land and Uprooting of Trees.

- The occupation forces demolished 17 houses and some crops in Rafah.
- Three houses were demolished by Israeli occupation forces near AL Mughraqa mosque.

4. Incursions in area "A" and arrests.

- In addition to the incursions in Rafah and AL Mughraqa, Israeli forces stormed in the following area:
- The Israeli army advanced and arrested two wounded Palestinians east of AL Maghazai\Gaza Strip.
- Israeli occupation forces arrested Ahmad Mohammed AL Ahmad in his house \Kofor AL Deek vilage\Salfet and Mohammed Abed AL Halim AL Shafi.
- Israeli occupation forces patrolled the bypass road south of Tolkarem, around AL Tiba checkpoint and the surrounding mountains. They prevented Palestinians from entering or leaving the city. They also chased down public vehicles that transport the citizens from and to the sand barriers, and prevented them from stopping behind the barriers. Israeli Patrols stationed at the junctions of Shofa, Safareen, Beit Leed and Rameen villages prevented Palestinians from entering or leaving the villages.
- The occupation forces stormed in Azzoun\Qalqilya, and searched many houses and vandalized its contents. They handed over several orders to the residents to report to the civil administration in Qadomeem settlement. More than 15 patrols and a large number of troops participated in the siege and the storming in of the village.
- Israeli forces movements and light flares were seen at the borderline to the east of AL Buraij camp.
- Israeli army near Dogeet settlement held a Palestinians ambulance.
- Five battle tanks and military jeeps were seen moving on the main road in Hawarah village. Many soldiers were deployed on the Yetschar settlement bypass road.
- A battle tank and two military personnel carriers were seen moving on Boreen-Madama Bypass road.
- The Israeli army backed up by battle tanks, military personnel carriers and bulldozers stormed in AL Qassas area\Rafah in area "A", and opened heavy fire at residents' houses who fled their homes that were bulldozed afterwards.

5. State of the Roads and border crossings.

- The occupation forces reinforced its military checkpoints on the main road and entrances of Jenin, Tolkarem and Nablus' villages and towns. They beefed up their military presence on Jenin-Tolkarem road near Ya'bed and erected new concrete blocks and prohibited Palestinians from using the road. Soldiers stationed there searched Palestinian vehicles and pedestrians. The main road between Nablus & Jenin is still closed down by the occupation forces who erected military checkpoints and prevented Palestinian vehicles from passing.
- Curfew is still imposed on Nablus where the occupation forces prevent people from entering or leaving the city. All main roads are also closed.
- The occupation forces closed down the main roads between Sabastia, Burqa and Bazaria villages and the roads leading to Tolkarem.

6. Settlements and settlers' aggressions.

- Jewish settlers built a new settlement point on the main road between Safareen and Beit Leed villages\Tolkarem.
- Jewish settlers opened fire at Palestinian houses wounding a 70-year-old Zakia Nofal in Safareen village\Tolkarem.
- Jewish settlers burnt tens of Dunums of olive trees in Azzoun AL Itma\Qalqilya
- Alon Moreh Jewish settlers opened fire at a Palestinian vehicle from Beit Foreek in Sahel Salem.
- Jewish settlers opened fire at Hawarah-Boreen junction and cut off electrical power supply from the village and attacked its houses.

- Preliminary losses of arson attacks by Jewish settlers are estimated at 3000 olive trees in Boreen village only.

Saturday June 23,m 19.00hrs/Sunday June 24:19:00hrs

1. Assassinations, killings and injuries

- A 29-year-old Usama Fathi Jawabra from Nablus was killed when the occupation forces detonated a bomb planted in a public telephone's cabin in Qaroyun\Nablus. The 4-year-old child Ammar Abed AL Nesser Shabaro and the 2-year-old- Malak Abed AL Nesser Shabaro were wounded in the blast and their father lost conscious.
- A 24-year-old Mohammed Walid Hamdan from Khan Younis died of his wounds sustained on June 9, during confrontations with the occupation forces at AL Tofah checkpoint.
- A 31-year-old Ghassan Zayed AL Fararja from Dehaisha\Beit Jala was wounded severely in his eye and face when the Israeli police beat him up.
- Two children were wounded by rubber coated bullets during confrontations near Qalandia camp with the occupation forces.

2. Gunfire with usage of range of weapons.

- The Israeli army breached the cease-fire agreement using machineguns' fire several times in the following areas, in addition to the breaches in paragraphs 1 and 6:
- The occupation forces opened machinegun fire without any justification at the bypass road near Zawata\Nablus.
- Israeli gunfire from battle tank stationed at point 24 to the east of Beit Hanoun.
- Light flares were fired by the Israeli forces stationed at point 54 and between point 40 & 50 to the east of Beit Hanoun junction at the demarcation line.
- Israeli gunfire from point 7 at the Egyptian border near Salah EL Din gate eastwards.
- The occupation forces fired sound and gas bombs at the citizens on Salem road and at Khamees Abed AL Razeq's vehicle from Kassrah.

3. Destruction, Leveling of Land and Uprooting of Trees.

- The total land that was burnt down by Jewish settler in Boreen village only is estimated at 1000 Dunums of olive trees.
- The occupation forces started bulldozing vast areas of land between Sika and Mughraqa mosque\Gaza Strip, including vegetables, crops, green houses and water wells.
- The occupation forces continued to bulldoze vast areas of land & uprooting trees on top of Jerzeem Mountain.

4. Incursions in area "A" and arrests.

- The policeman Salama Mohammed Ishtia was arrested at a checkpoint near Boreen village on his way to work.
- The occupation forces arrested Sultan Abed Qader Zeeb in Nabi Saleh\Ramallah and Kammal Atiya Dwaik on Sirda checkpoint.
- The occupation forces deployed additional military reinforcements on the entrances of Ramallah and the surrounding areas, in addition to the erection of a high watchtower equipped with two high caliber machineguns. They also stationed two battle tanks at the northern entrance of AL Birah near Jawwal center.
- Israeli occupation forces on the Kafriyat checkpoint attacked several Palestinians among them Ahmad Ali & Mohammed Nofal from AL Ras village when they were trying to reach Tolkarem through unpaved roads.
- The Israeli forces launched aerial patrols using combat helicopters on the roads between Nablus, Tolkarem, Sabastia, Bazaria and Masaudia and they conducted mock attacks at the vehicles on the bypass roads.
- The deployment of large contingent of Israeli forces accompanied by 5 military jeeps and maps on point 199 to the east of Sofa crossing\Rafah.

- The Israeli army combed areas near Shafi Shomron settlement and on the bypass road Kadomeem using light flares.
- Israeli patrols stormed in Seelat AL Thohor village and Mahmoud Saleh Abu Khader's house, and beat up his wife and children.
- The occupation forces are imposing a strict siege on Bazaria, Sabastia and Burqa\Nablus and prevented the citizens from entering or leaving. They also arrested Munadel Azaam from Sabastia and confiscated his excavator.
- The Israeli occupation forces started to reinforce its military positions on top of Jerzeem Mountain and erected several watchtowers.
- The occupation forces continued its presence on Azzoun's town playground, which overlooks the whole town. Large occupation forces' presence was seen in the area.
- The occupation forces dug a trench two days ago at a width of 5 meters, 3 meters depth and 8 Kilometers long that connects the military checkpoint between Al Hamra and Baqa'ot settlements in AL Aghwar. This step is aimed at isolating the road to Buqai'a area to prevent the movement of Palestinians. The lives of thousands of sheep are threatened because owners are prevented from bringing water to their herds.
- The occupation forces detained Palestinians for several hours on Dair Sharaf checkpoint and opened fire at them, and then they forced the passengers out of their cars and into buses that transported them to Nablus after they confiscated their car keys.

5. State of the Roads and border crossings.

- The occupation forces beefed up its siege on West Bank's roads and closed down most of the roads leading to Hebron, Tolkarem, Arqoub area, Jenin and Bethlehem-AL Khader – Hebron, road. They also deployed checkpoints on the roads leading to east Bethlehem. And enforced its presence and checkpoints on the roads leading to Jericho. In addition, they closed down all the roads in the Governorate with the exception of the eastern road where military checkpoints were erected.

6. Settlements and settlers' aggressions.

- The occupation forces reinforced its military presence between Shilo and Raheel settlements. The building of settlement roads continued and more caravans were brought in to the east of Jalood.
- Karny Shomron Jewish settlers attacked the car of a 38- year- old Palestinian policeman Faisal Abu Baker with rocks near Kufor Laqef\Qalqilya. He sustained head injuries and a concussion.
- Elich Jewish settlers attacked and beat up Palestinians from Laban AL Sharqia\Ramallah while they were working in their farms. They also opened fire at Palestinians citizens and a 43-year-old Kamel Khader was wounded in the lower part of the face and chest.
- Jewish settlers from AL Sahla\Hebron attacked Daoud family and Intisar Ahmad Daoud was wounded in the face.
- Jewish settlers' car intercepted a Palestinian Liaison vehicle and poured insults at them in front of the Israeli checkpoint.

Sunday June 24: 19.00hrs/ Monday June 25:19.00hrs

1. Assassinations, killings and injuries

- A 6-year-old child Imad Walid Nijm was wounded while he was in his house yard in the southern mountain area\Nablus with a bullet fired by the occupation forces stationed on the opposite mountain.
- The occupation forces opened fire at three Palestinians wounding one of them at Majdoleem junction.
- The Israeli army fired a gas bomb inside a 27-year-old Amjad Abdallah Ali's vehicle from Jit village who lost conscious.

- An 11-year-old child Mohammed Hussein Ashour from Khan Younis was wounded by shrapnel in the head, when Israeli occupation forces fired three shells at a group of children who were playing in the municipality park.
- A 17-year-old youth Hamed Dereyah from Aqraba\Nablus was wounded after being shot at by the occupation forces.

2. Gunfire with usage of range of weapons.

- The Israeli army breached the cease-fire agreement using machineguns' and artillery's fire several times in the following areas, in addition to the breaches in paragraphs 1 and 7:
- The occupation forces opened fire from Salah El Din gate eastwards.
- The occupation forces fired two shells at Tal AL Sultan neighborhood\Rafah
- The occupation forces fired several light flares over Tal AL Sultan area\Rafah. One of the residential houses was burnt down after a light flare fell on it.
- The occupation forces bombarded residential houses in Abu Snanina, Takrory and AL Sheikh neighborhoods using high caliber machineguns.
- The occupation forces bombarded Salah EL Din gate and Brazil neighborhood\Rafah.
- Indiscriminate gunfire from Sanour military camp\Jenin at Sanour town that damaged several residential houses.
- Heavy gunfire at the green line to the east of Maghazi\Gaza by the occupation forces.
- The occupation forces opened its high caliber machineguns at residential houses in Shuwaika neighborhood\Tolkarem.
- A military personnel carrier opened fire northward at point 6 on the Egyptian border (Bahloul Gas Station).
- The occupation forces opened fire at residential houses in Aqraba to the east of Nablus while two military helicopters hovered over the area.

3. Confiscation of lands:

- The Israeli army started to confiscate thousands of Dunums near Moraj settlement\Rafah and surrounded it with barbed wire in a preparatory step to annex it to the settlement security zone.

4. Destruction, Leveling of Land and Uprooting of Trees.

- The occupation forces uprooted 100 olive plants in Kufor AL Lobad in Khirbet Ras AL Shomer\Tolkarem to build a military point in the area.
- A military bulldozer accompanied by two battle tanks bulldozed vast areas of land on the border strip in Qarara to the east of Khan Younis.

5. Incursions in area "A" and arrests.

- The Israeli army arrested Jihad Abedrahman Daoud on the western entrance to Hares village\Salfeet.
- The occupation forces arrested Fateh Abedalfatah AL Samman from Nablus at the military checkpoint near Sabastia junction.
- The general security apparatus arrested two residents of Ramallah Abedalaziz Salha, 20 years old and Mohammed Nora, 18 years old.
- The occupation forces arrested 7 Palestinians from AL Saweyah village to the east of Jerusalem.
- The Israeli army arrested an 18-year-old student Ahmad Mahmoud Hawajrah and a 30-year-old Khalil Abu Rjaila from Khuza'\Khan Younis at Rafah border crossing while they were coming back from Egypt.
- The Israeli army arrested Raed Rajeh Hanany and Fares Fawwaz Hananay from Beit Foreek\Nablus.
- The Israeli army imposed a curfew on area H2 in Hebron.
- The Israeli army stormed in Aqraba village\Nablus using seven military jeeps.
- The occupation forces deployed more military enforcements in Shuwaika area\Tolkarem and moved its military machinery to friction points in the area. They

also continued their strict curfew on Beit Leed and Safareen villages to the east of Tolkarem for the seventh consecutive day.

- The Israeli army stormed in several houses in Dair Istai, searched them and destroyed their furniture and damaged their food supplies.
- A battle tank and a bulldozer entered from point 157 on the green line to the east of Qarara 70 meters into the Palestinian territories and leveled lands in the area.
- There are 2 bulldozers, 2 battle tanks and a crane at point 79 to the north of Karni crossing erecting concrete blocks and a military fortress.

6. State of the Roads and border crossings.

- The occupation forces re-closed Qalandia military checkpoint on Ramallah-Jerusalem road after it was partially opened. The majority of the main & minor roads remained closed and checkpoints are spread all over the opened roads.
- The occupation forces enforced its military presence on several checkpoints in Ein Areek and Dair Ibzee'

7. Settlements and settlers' aggressions.

- The Israeli army moved 10 truckloads of concrete, 7 truckloads of tiles and one truckload of cement blocks to Netzarim settlement.
- The occupation forces started to bulldoze Palestinian lands near Najhout settlement to the west of Dora\Hebron. They also transported new caravans to the area.
- Jewish settlers burnt olive, grape, strawberry and lemon trees in Ras Karkar to the west of Ramallah.
- Tens of Jewish settlers closed down Hebron-Bethlehem road.
- Jewish settlers damaged 47 car tires in Wadi AL Jooz neighborhood to the east of Jerusalem.
- Under the protection of the Israeli army, Jewish settlers continued to confiscate a 20-Dunums land from Jinsafout village\Qalqilya for the fifth consecutive day.
- Jewish settlers attacked Palestinian merchants in AL Hisba AL Qadima and destroyed its contents.
- Jewish settlers burnt land in Bani Naim\Hebron estimated at 200 Dunums.
- Jewish settlers attacked Nisfat Abu Baker, 41 years old from Mirda village who was admitted to the hospital.

Monday June 25: 19.00hrs/Tuesday June 26: 19.00hrs

1. Assassinations, killings and injuries

- The Israeli occupation forces opened fire at Palestinian citizens in Amal and Namsawi neighborhoods\Khan Younis injuring three Palestinians.
- Occupation forces opened fire and wounded a Palestinian citizen from Salem village\Nablus. Not only they prevented the ambulance from transporting the wounded but also forced the medics to take off their clothes and stand nude where people were detained including journalist Jafar Ishtia.

2. Gunfire with usage of range of weapons.

- The Israeli army breached the cease-fire agreement using machineguns' fire several times in the following areas, in addition to the breaches in paragraphs 1 and 6:
- Israeli gunfire from point 7 on the security line, Delta area.
- Indiscriminate gunfire on the sandy road near Dogeet Settlement.
- Gunfire on the Zwata-Assera bypass road in Nablus.
- Israeli gunfire along with light flares from Kfar Darom settlement's green houses.
- Gunfire on Salem village to the east of Nablus that terrorized Palestinian citizens.
- The occupation forces opened gunfire at a civilian vehicle from an ambush on Dair AL Hatab road in Nablus.
- A military frigate opened fire at fishermen's nets in Rafah.

- The occupation forces opened fire at a number of demonstrators near AL Haj Fadel factory on the eastern road\Gaza.

3. Destruction, Leveling of Land and Uprooting of Trees.

- Israeli bulldozer leveled lands to the east of road no. 4 opposite to Mahfouza post\Khan Younis.

4. Incursions in area "A" and arrests.

- The occupation forces arrested Mufdi Zuhdi Nasasra from Beit Foreek village on the bypass road between Salem and Beit Foreek and confiscated his tractor.
- The occupation forces arrested 27-year-old Majed Subhi Ahmad from Kufor Al Deek\Salfeet.
- The occupation forces arrested Feras Ahmad AL Biyari near Ofer military camp, Suliman Ahmad Rizq from Hizma, Hassan Mohammed AL Za'el from Zaboba and Ibrahim Ahmad Awwad on Aqraba junction checkpoint.
- Large contingents of Israeli forces stormed in Shwaika neighborhood and several houses in Tolkarem. They arrested six Palestinians: Abdallah Atiya Mahdawi, Anas Walid Musameh, Jawwad Claiby\Najjah University student, 11-year-old Ahmad Satti Ghanem, 25-year-old Ahmad Mohammed Ghanem and 24-year-old Iyad Hosni Nasser.
- Large contingents of Israeli forces stormed in many houses in Seelat AL Thohor, which is under curfew since last Thursday and destroyed its furniture and vandalized them.
- The occupation forces erected a military checkpoint consisting of two patrols on the entrance of Rojeeb village. They checked people's IDs and insulted them.
- The occupation forces at 1 AM held Khalil Hosni Ishtia, Iyad Hosni Ishta, and Ihab Hussein Ishtia on Salem checkpoint and prevented them from transporting the 6-year-old sick child Hosni Khalil Ishtia.
- A large contingent of occupation forces destroyed farmers' kiosks and stores and confiscated their products along with a tractor and a cart in Bardala area in AL Aghwar AL Shamalia.
- The occupation forces chased down with the help of police dogs Palestinian workers at AL Taiba checkpoint while they were trying to reach their jobs and detained one of the workers. They deployed more enforcement to Avni Hefetz settlement to the southeast of Tolkarem.
- A helicopter, military movements and light flares at point 112, 108 on the green line to the east of AL Buraij camp\Gaza.
- Two battle tanks entered a distance of 50 meters into area "A" at point 150 on the green line south of Kissufeem crossing.
- A battle tank entered 30 meters into area "A" at point 158 on the green line to the east of Qarara\Khan Younis.
- Two helicopters are hovering over point 71 on the green line to the east of Sheja'ea\Gaza and fired 4 light flares.
- Under the protection of the Israeli army, a bulldozer dug and destroyed the road leading to the main road near Jawwal center\Ramallah.
- The Israeli army dug the road leading to Bazaria village on Jenin-Nablus road, leading to the destruction of the water forcemain again.
- The occupation forces started to build a new military post on Qarna Abu Zihri hill between Dair Nizam and Aboud villages\Ramallah.
- The occupation forces positioned a machinegun on top of a room at Bazaria junction in area "A" and prevented people and vehicles to pass from the main road.
- The occupation forces beefed up its military patrols deployed on the road connecting Qalqilya and Nablus particularly near the entrances of Palestinian villages.

- Jerusalem municipality servants confiscated Palestinian vendor's products in Bab AL Amood, Sultan and Salah EL Din roads. They also detained them in Qashla prison in Bab AL Khalil.
- The Israeli army erected a watchtower 20 meters from the existing one on the new gate in AL Muntar area\Gaza.

5. State of the Roads and border crossings.

- All West Bank's roads are still closed except Nablus-AL Bazan road. A closure was re-imposed on Hebron, Nablus and Jenin. Military checkpoints are spread over some minor opened roads. Bypass roads became dangerous to Palestinian passengers because of ambushes and chases by the occupation forces and Jewish settlers.

6. Settlements and settlers' aggressions.

- Annab Jewish settlers uprooted olive trees between Kufor AL Lobad and Beit Leed villages\Tolkarem.
- Jewish settlers burnt agricultural lands in Azzoun town near Ma'aleh Shomron settlement.
